This year we have made some changes to our Mid Year summary report. The report is designed to be a prompt for the Mid Year Parent-Teacher interviews. The classroom teachers are looking forward to meeting with you to talk about the progress your child is making.

The report indicates the level where students are achieving in relation to the curriculum level expectations for their year level in the areas of Reading, Writing and Mathematics. These levels are based on students' current achievement.

In the example below a Year 2 child should be working within Level 1 of the curriculum. Based on a range of assessment tools and the teacher's knowledge of their achievement the child would be considered to be working at the appropriate level for their year level.
